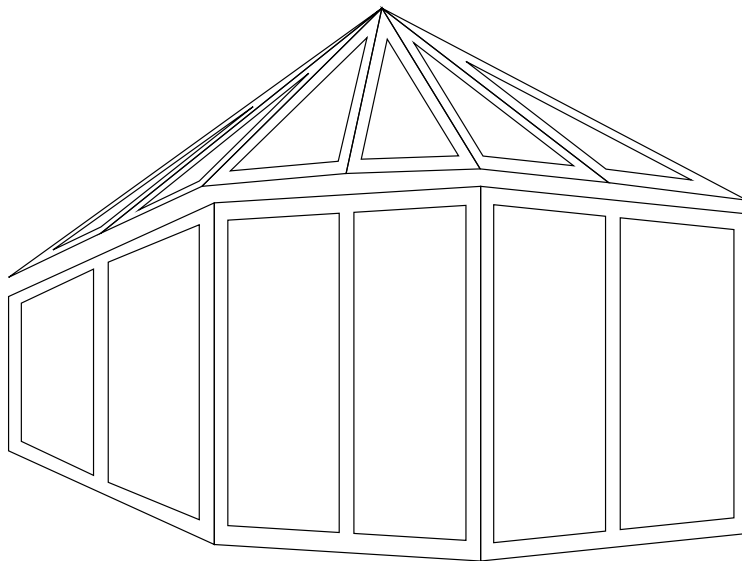


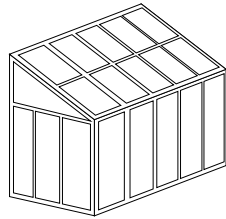

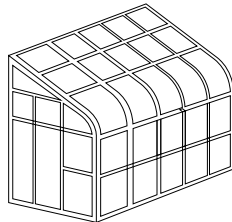
Conservatory Triangle





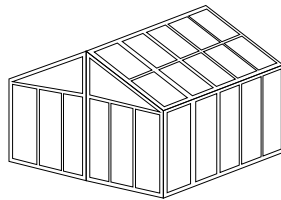

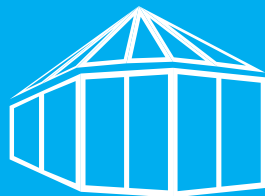

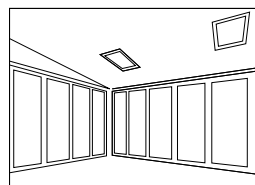

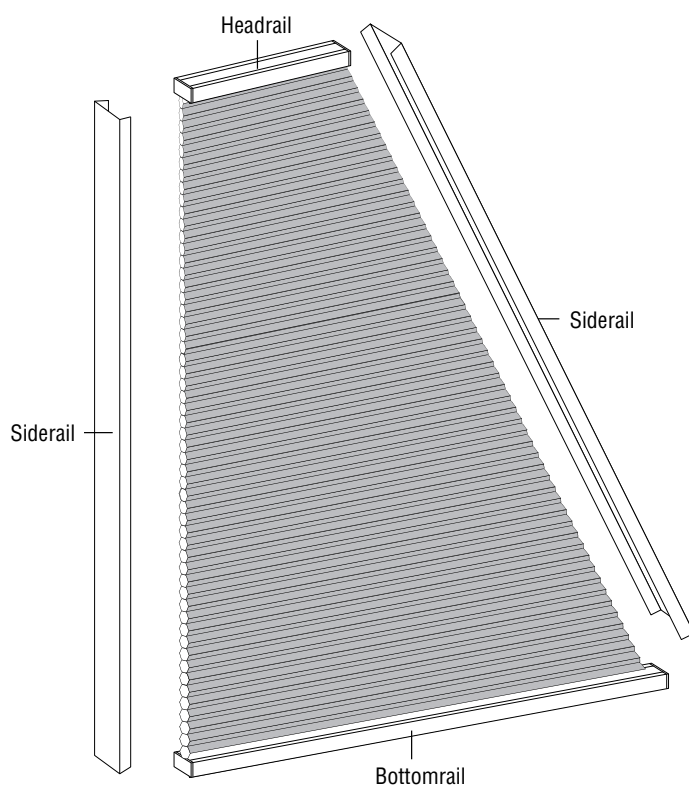

Expanded Hardware Diagram

1.) Dry fit the track for the triangular section.



2.) Mark the top of the tracks so that a gap of 2" is achieved.



3.) Measure the length of the right and left side tracks.



4.) Miter the top of the angled track.



5.) Miter the bottom of the angled track.



6.) Check angle.



7.) Remove, trim back and reinstalled the rubber insert so that it clears the 1" track



8.) Install side track into the straight side of triangle.



9.) Install side track into the angled side of the triangle.



10.) Play safe, measure twice and cut once.

➤ *Top of the tracks to match precisely.*



11.) Get ready to install the shade by removing end caps from small headrail.

- 12.) Cradle shade into bottom and pull fabric towards the top.

- 13.) This is a close up of the headrail which gets locked into the top of the 2 side tracks.

- 14.) Make sure all fabric is sitting inside the tracing system.



-
- 15.) Gentle clean up with magic eraser.

➤ *Conservatory Triangle is removable, not retractable.*

Trouble Shooting

	Problem	Solution
A	The shade is falling out of the side tracks.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Remove slat insert from top cell. • Reinstall the slat insert into the next cell below. • This reduces the length of the shade by about 3/4". • Adjust as required to ensure the shade no longer falls out of the side tracks.
B	The shade appears to sit lopsided within the side tracks.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Manual adjust pleats by pushing and/or pulling until the shade no longer appears lopsided.

Care and Cleaning

Honeycomb shades are made of an anti-static, dust-resistant fabric which repels dirt and dust. For most honeycomb fabrics, the following options are available if your shade needs cleaning.

DUSTING

Regular light dusting with a feather duster is all the cleaning that is needed in most circumstances.

VACUUMING

Use a hand-held vacuum with low suction for more thorough dust removal.

SPOT-CLEANING

- Prepare a solution of warm water and a mild detergent.
- Dampen a clean cloth in the solution and wring it out.
- Dab the spot with the dampened cloth until it is gone. Do not rub the fabric.
- Allow the shade to dry in the completely lowered position.

DEEP CLEANING

- Immerse the shade in a basin or bathtub filled with a mild detergent. Never immerse the headrail into the solution.
- Rinse with clean water.
- Fully raise the shade and tilt to eliminate excess water.
- Reinstall the damp shade, lower it, and let it dry completely.

ULTRASONIC CLEANING

Some honeycomb fabrics can be ultrasonically cleaned by a professional.

- Specify that a mild detergent solution be used.
- Never immerse the headrail into the solution.
- Dry the shade completely in the lowered position.

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
